Roscoe is actually Francis's sister Rachel, who is posing as her dead brother to collect money from her fiancée's father. Francis also takes a second job with Stanley Stubbers, Rachel's boyfriend who killed her brother and is hiding from the police. To avoid discovery, Francis must keep his two bosses apart.

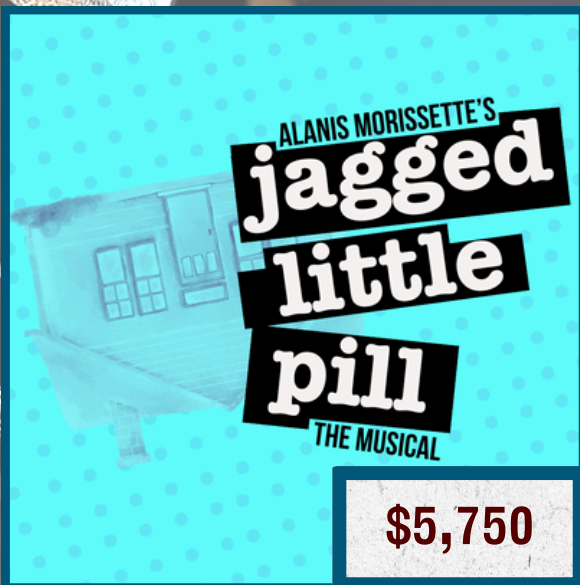

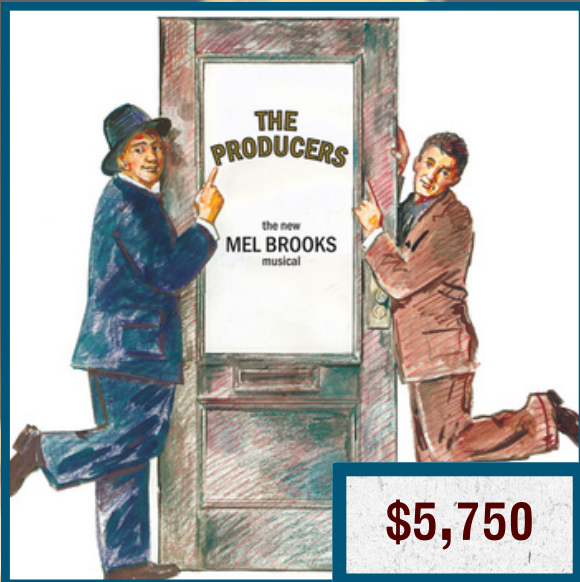
